

## Ruth's Beef 'n Cabbage

Some guy with an Irish last name who lives in South Georgia, but grew up in Upstate NY, reminisces of a Polish dish while discovering Minnesota...

Have you found that there're some things that you hated as a kid, but something befuddling happened along the way and now you love it? That my story with cabbage. In particular, the creation brought to my area of the world by my Polish brothers and sisters, Golabki (cabbage rolls).

I went to Minnesota a few months back and learned of their custom of Hot Dishes. Since casseroles aren't necessarily restaurant fare, I had to order away for "The Great Minnesota Hot Dish" cookbook. Tonight, I tried "Ruth's Beef 'n Cabbage" hot dish, and I realized that, "Hey, this is about as good as Golabki and I don't have to go through the trouble of streaming cabbage leaves." You might be able to add a little tomato paste, maybe a little sugar, but it's definitely a keeper for me.

1  $\frac{1}{2}$  pounds ground beef, seasoned with  $\frac{1}{4}$  teaspoon salt  
1 cup chopped onions  
2 cloves garlic, chopped  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  medium size green bell pepper, chopped  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  cup chopped celery  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  cup uncooked long grain regular white rice  
1 teaspoon salt  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  teaspoon ground black pepper  
1 medium size cabbage, sliced  
1 12-ounce can tomato-vegetable juice

Pre-heat oven to 350

In a saucepan, over medium heat, stir and cook beef, onions, garlic, bell pepper and celery until meat is browned; drain the fat. Add rice, salt and black pepper; mix well. In a 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  quart glass baking dish, layer sliced cabbage and meat mixture, ending with cabbage. Pour tomato-vegetable juice over all. Cover and bake 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  hours. Serves 6. (if those 6 people don't like it all that much)


