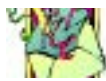

## Potato Chip-Crusted Chicken Strips with Honey Mustard Dipping Sauce

### Ingredients:

#### Chicken:

1 cup all-purpose flour  
2 teaspoons garlic powder  
2 teaspoons onion powder  
1 teaspoon paprika  
1 teaspoon ground mustard  
Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper  
3 large eggs  
16 to 20 ounces your favorite BBQ or salt and vinegar potato chips (I like Zapp's Voodoo)  
2 pounds boneless chicken breast, cut into strips

#### Honey Mustard Sauce:

1/2 cup honey  
5 tablespoons mayonnaise  
1/4 cup Dijon mustard  
1 tablespoon yellow mustard  
1 tablespoon whole-grain mustard  
1/4 teaspoon garlic powder  
Kosher salt



### Directions:

Preheat the oven to 450 degrees F. Line a baking sheet with parchment.

- In a bowl or baking dish, add the flour, garlic powder, onion powder, paprika, ground mustard and 2 teaspoons each salt and pepper and stir to combine. Beat the eggs in a separate baking dish. Finely crush the potato chips in their bag or in a separate resealable bag. Pour into a bowl or baking dish.
- Sprinkle the chicken with 2 teaspoons salt. Dip the chicken in the seasoned flour and coat completely, then into the egg mixture until completely coated. Finally, dip the chicken into the potato chips, making sure the chips stick to the whole surface. Transfer the chicken to the prepared baking sheet.
- Bake, flipping halfway through, until the chicken is golden brown and reaches an internal temperature of 165 degrees F, about 20 minutes.
- For the honey mustard sauce: While the chicken is baking, mix together the honey, mayonnaise, Dijon, yellow mustard, whole-grain mustard and garlic powder in a small bowl. Season with salt as desired. Serve with the chicken.

## September Skills Day George Engler

Today was a Skills Day for the books, had a new Sandie join us, Jeff K. You can beat him up on his lousy taste in motorcycle clubs when we send his Hidey Ho. It was the largest crowd since The Pandemic started; 18 Sandies participated in our Skills today. Another fantastic factoid, The Sandies had 7, yes 7, different brands/types of motorcycles out there today. That is more than you'll see on an average used bike lot. In alphabetical order so as not to play favorites: BMW, Harley, Honda, Indian, Triumph, Yamaha, and Zero - we had everything from Adventure bikes to a Zero EV and all things in between.

What made this Sandie Skills so very special was the presence of The Four. The Four consists of Michael (Sensei) M, Dave (Sir Mac) M, Chris ( The Mitchell ) M and JoeJoe ( JoeJoe) R. The amount of teaching talent out there was phenomenal, the level of professionalism and the Skill The Four applied helping us get better was nothing short of incredible.

Like The Mitchell just said "quit looking at the cones" Sensei "look where you want to go" Sir Mac just looked like a big orange safety cone (The International Hunter Safety Orange sun HAT complete with 'hat-kilt' must be seen to be believed). JoeJoe laid out a super warm-up course, it had all the warm up exercises we needed to get started. Thank you again to The Four you made today a great learning experience.

Then we have the rest of The Herd. Actually, we have some very talented folks in The Sandies unfortunately none were there today. (HA! Had to do it, it was caused by unknown forces.) There were some good riders out there today. Of course Mr. Electro ( Jim M) was out with that damn Zero. It is just so quiet that it's unnerving . It has been so long and it's easy to forget this stuff. That is the very reason we do Skills Days.

Dawn H was a little worried about one of the full range exercises that Sensei was putting together. Dawn needn't have worried Dawn did just great. The reason Dawn does great and is such a good rider is Dawn pays attention when the "how to" briefing is presented. Unlike the rest of us Knuckleheads who are watching but already think we know it. Then promptly discover just opposite and The Coaches have their job cut-out for them.

Joe W really did a good job at Skills, there is a video of Joe in the BOX. Joe makes it look easy with that 1,000-pound Gold Wing.

Frank W, what can I say, he is a hopeless raconteur and ladies' man. At lunch a group of women were sitting at a table near Frank. Next thing I know Frank is chatting them up. Can't take that boy anywhere it seems without drawing a crowd.
